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Google Finance Fetches current or historical securities information from various sources. To access this information, use the GOOGLFINANCE function. The syntax is:GOOGLFINANCE(ticker, [attribute], [start_date], [end_date]num_days, [interval])* ticker - The ticker symbol for the security to consider (e.g., "NASDAQ:GOOG" instead of just "GOOG").* attribute - The attribute to fetch about the ticker from Google Finance. This is optional and defaults to "price." Common attributes include: * "price" - Real-time price quote, delayed by up to 20 minutes. * "priceopen" - The price as of market open. * "high" - The current day's high price. * "low" - The current day's low price. * "volume" - The current day's trading volume. * "marketcap" - The market capitalization of the stock * start_date - The start date when fetching historical data. If specified but no end\ date\ num\ days is provided, only the single day's data will be returned.* end_date\ num\ days - The end date when fetching historical data or the number of days from start\ date for which to return data. This parameter can also be used with interval as a string ("DAILY" or "WEEKLY").* interval - The frequency of returned data; either "DAILY" or "WEEKLY". This can also be specified as 1 or 7.The GOOGLFINANCE function will return an array with column headers, but some attributes might not yield results for all symbols. If any date parameters are specified, the request is considered historical and only the historical attributes are allowed. Note that GOOGLFINANCE is only available in English and does not support most international exchanges. When using historical data, it cannot be downloaded or accessed via the Sheets API or Apps Script, resulting in a #N/A error instead of actual values. Although quotes may be sourced from all markets, they might be delayed by up to 20 minutes. The information provided is 'as is' and only for informational purposes, not for trading decisions or advice.Google treats dates passed into GOOGLFINANCE as noon UTC time, which means exchanges that close before this time may be shifted by a day. For instance, if you use the function with a date, the result will be based on the specified date without any adjustments.

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
