Cliquez ensuite sur « Premier baiser » lorsque vos Sims s'entendent déjà bien. En général, les Sims acceptent de le faire peu de temps après que cette option vous soit proposée. Votre Sim devrait maintenant s'engager fermement avec l'autre Sim. Pour cela, cliquez à nouveau sur « Romantique » puis sur « Demander à être amité ». Si vous essayez un échec, n'hésitez pas à essayer d'autres interactions. Si le flirt ne fonctionne pas, essayez de faire une blague. Pour mieux se connaître, l'option « Demander un rendez-vous » est également utile. C'est là que les Sims peuvent se rapprocher. Si vous persévérez suffisamment longtemps, vous pouvez débloquer l'action « Faire une demande en mariage ». Celle-ci se trouve également à nouveau sous « Romantique ». Mariage des Sims - ce qu'il faut retenir Lorsque vous avez enfin débloqué l'interaction, ne laissez pas les Sims se marier tout de suite. La plupart du temps, cela se passe mal. Ici, vous avez le choix et devez agir en fonction des souhaits de vos Sims. Les Sims les plus romantiques souhaitent souvent une grande fête. Lorsque vous avez décidé d'organiser une grande fête, vous devez accomplir les tâches qui vous sont confiées pendant celle-ci. Comme pour toutes les autres fêtes, c'est essentiel pour réussir. Pour épouser un Sim lors de la fête de mariage, cliquez sur celui-ci et sélectionnez « Épouser un Sim ».
